

### **Understanding SNP Poll Test Results**

Neogen Australasia moved to SNP based DNA testing in September 2017. The move to SNP based testing means that we now have a far more accurate test for Poll in both taurine and indicine cattle.

Previously used Beef CRC based Poll tests would return a result and an accuracy (eg. Homozygous Polled 98%). With SNP based Poll testing multiple genetic markers located close to the Poll gene can be identified. This means we can predict Poll with a lot more accuracy. The specific Poll allele/s found are reported as subscripts (Celtic Pc, Friesian Pf).

When reporting Poll test results from a SNP based test, the results will be reported as seen below:

# Redline Brangus & Ultra Reds

## The Dingle's focus remains on market relevant constitutional bred - Red Brangus Cattle.

The Dingle's view on breeding stud seedstock, while maintaining a commercial focus, to ensure that genetic gain and market opportunities can be achieved easily by those who invest in Redline genetics remains strong. This has been the primary factor behind the growth of our herd for over five generations.

Our Red Brangus females are the pillars of the operation. The cows graze year-round on natural forest country and are seasonally joined. Years worth of focus on fertility within the breeding herd is optimal. Cows are culled from the herd if they do not wean a calf or fail an annual preg-test, undesirable temperaments, bad udder and assisted births are all rare, but traits that are also removed from the herd.

The Dingle's maintain a modern bull operation. EBVs have been adopted, raw data is collected and submitted, along with DNA, genomics and muscle scanning. Semen and morphology testing for bulls is undertaken at an early age, this helps determine early maturity and sire trends. Majority of the bulls are sold directly from the paddock, extensive data and information is provided on each bull to help buyers with bull selection. The bulls are

prepared on grass and occasionally assisted with lucerne silage in dry seasons to help guarantee they are ready for paddock duties and able to acclimatize to work conditions with ease.

With the current importance on pasture management, market relevance and profit driven factors, the Redline breeding program maintains all measures to be able to comply with current market trends. Thus, can be seen through the surplus Redline breeding stock that go on to be easily finished on grass, grade MSA, are EU accredited with grasslands compliance.

Keeping all these crucial breeding principles in mind, the 2025 Redline Brangus Fitzroy crossing sale draft consist of 10 constitutionally bred bulls. The bulls have been selected on phenotype and genotype, are homozygous poll, semen and morphology tests, show good growth attributes and have excellent temperaments.







Our aim is to breed functional, environmentally adapted cattle that can not only grow fat in the good seasons but survive and reproduce in the all too frequent droughts. We are based on several properties throughout Southern Qld ranging from ticky coastal forest country to Buffel grass pastures and Mulga in arid outback Qld. Our main properties, Pinnacle and Yanna, are located at Charleville in the extensive pastoral region of South West Qld.


Aside from the obvious non-negotiable standards of structural soundness and temperament we focus almost entirely on putting selection pressure on our herd for fertility. We have followed this track for 50 years. Our theory is that only sound adapted cattle can thrive in our environment enough to conceive and rear a calf annually through floods and droughts. We view the hard times as an opportunity to further advance the ability of our herd to drive profitability in yours. The result of our selection process is a higher Brahman content herd with growth rates and reproductive rates well above breed averages and suited to diverse markets and conditions — a combination of Bos indicus adaptation with meat quality, poll genetics, reliable temperament, and high fertility. Our cattle are proven suitable for all markets from local trade and MSA to live export.

In addition to being morphology tested our 2025 draft is tested clear of Pompes and Pestivirus diseases, as well as being DNA sire identified, poll gene tested and carcass scanned. They have been selected for the catalogue on Dam and Sire fertility records and Genetic analysis. The entire draft is polled, with most being double polled. The Valera Vale stud is powered by numbers; by the sheer size of the herd (by far the largest registered Droughtmaster herd in australia), and by the genetic. genomic and phenotypic data.

# By-Mingo Droughtmasters

By-Mingo Droughtmasters, run by Don & Robyn Roberton, is located just outside Biggenden in the North Burnett. We started running a commercial Droughtmaster herd in 1991 and registered the By-Mingo Stud in 2003.

Our herd now comprises of around 160 Registered breeders which are managed the same as a commercial operation – no special treatments. Fertility, good udders, and a naturally quiet temperament are paramount. A detailed breeding history is recorded on every female.

Cattle are handled with horses & motorbikes and with & without dogs. Weaners are yard weaned and tailed out with horses and then educated to bikes & dogs.

We sell approx. 40 bulls per year with the majority sold straight out of the paddock. A line of select bulls are sold at Fitzroy Crossing in August, the Bunya Sale in September and at the Roma & Clermont Sales in October.

After weaning, the bulls are grown on dryland grass pastures until

about 15-18 months of age and are then rotationally grazed through a Leucaena/grass pasture system.

They are given a home-made ration in the 2-3 months prior to sale to give them a more polished sale condition. We advocate that our bulls must still have that browse & forage instinct and not to rely on a grain feeder.

We aim to breed cattle that are industry relevant, and over the past 34 years we have successfully targeted several different markets including Jap Ox, EU and 100d Grain fed.

In recent years, we have found that suppling yearling animals to the Grassfed MSA program to be very effective. We have supplied both steers and heifers to this market and have achieved a 98% MSA compliance.



Maunsell Park Droughtmasters was established in 2008 by Chris Turner and registered with the Droughtmaster Society as Stud Number 1333. Alongside a commercial breeding and cattle trading operation, the small stud herd was grown through the purchase of a handful of select females from leading studs. The breeder herd now currently consists of 120 stud and commercial Droughtmaster breeders running across country in the Coalstoun Lakes area of the North Burnett, and across three leased paddocks in the Gympie Region

The stud is focused on breeding cattle with quiet temperaments, structural correctness, red meat value all while upholding fertility – females calving every year with good udders; weaning a calf of quality and to go back in calf. Any females who don't meet these criteria are culled out.

Strict sire selection over the years has influenced solid foundations, most notably Billabong Tennessee (Billabong Godfrey) breeding slick coated cattle with quiet temperaments and females with perfect udders; while Glenlands D Quart (Glenlands D Freemantle) providing cattle with natural carcase

without compromising on fertility. Both sires were still sound into their teens. Current sires represented in the Maunsell Park herds are Mungalla 4156 (Lamont Pablo), Carnudge Jed and Hamadra Muzz (Calioran Robbie).

We have offered bulls for sale direct out of the paddock, through the Droughtmaster National Sale and February All Breeds Sale in Rockhampton. All enquiries are welcome.

# Fitzroy Crossing Committee - Week Scholarship

On the 7th of October 2024, myselfandWesWortleytravelled and landed in Rockhampton, Queensland to begin our 10day scholarship over Brahman Week. This trip included visiting vendor properties, bull/heifer sales and meatworks.

We started the week by first visiting CQLX (Central Queensland Livestock Exchange) for its Rockhampton Brahman Week Sale. Here we were looking at Bulls with Johnny Edwards and learning about what he focuses in wanting for a Stud breeding bull for his Queenslander line.

The following day, we travelled to Steve Farmer's property – SC Droughtmaster Stud. Here we got to do a farm tour and get an understanding of what goes into the preparation and feeding of young bulls. Later that evening, we drove to the French Brahmans T Division Female Sale at 'The Great Western' in Rockhampton. This was such an eye opening, exciting sale, getting to witness heifers being sold for such a strong bidding presence.

We started out at CQLX, feeding and organising a truck for the bull Johnny purchased back to Gayndah. After that we went to Rocky Repro (semen collecting and storage facility). This is where studs take their bulls to get "milked" (semen collected), tested and frozen. At the facility they do a lot of importing and exporting semen,

to export semen the bull must go through all the same processes and vaccination's as if the bull itself was going to be exported. The bulls can be held at the property for up to 100 days and be milked every day, until they have a desired amount of straws. This facility is so large it can hold millions of straws inside, to be exported all over the globe.

On one of the days, we travelled to Clermont for the first Queenslander and Tropical Red Invitational Bull Sale. When we arrived, we helped with preparing the bulls for the sale. This included washing them, painting numbers on and penning up into designated areas. The sale was held on the 12th of October. This sale wasn't very successful with only 30 out of 104 bulls being sold during the sale. However, over the next few days afterwards, all bulls were able to be sold privately, so no vendors had to take any bulls home.

We travelled down south and completed farm tours of Barlyne, Barboot and Muan which included Big Meats their abattoir, and the feedlot set up where vendors send their bulls for feeding and to get quiet and be around people before they are sold.

We then travelled to the vendor, Michael Flynn (Valeravale Droughtmasters) in Ipswich. We went to one of his properties where we drafted off his stud bulls and got to in person help/watch him collect semen from the bulls and be counted/ studied under a microscope on property. Michael also went into detail explaining the benefits of morphology, including potential fertility issues. Allowing producers to select bulls with higher

quality sperm, leading to increased calving rate, tighten calving periods and ultimately improved herd productivity by ensuring more cows become pregnant and produce good healthy calves.

We spoke in length about the positives of having strong herd genetics, including increased production efficiency through faster growth rates, better feed conversion, higher carcass quality, improved disease resistance and better reproductive performance. Thinas also like enhanced adaptability to their environment and the ability to select specific traits, like temperament, horn, rib fats and scrotal size.

To finish out the tour we where lucky enough to get a tour of JBS Processing Plant at Dinmore. Dinmore is the largest beef abattoir in the southern hemisphere, with daily production of 3,350 head per day and an onsite staff base of approximately 2000 people. Making it the largest employer in the Ipswich region. The processing plant underwent a \$50 million upgrade in 1999, bringing in some of the most advanced technology the industry to improve daily production. The Dinmore processing plant is located in Ipswich, which is less than an hour from Brisbane ensuring they can always export their meat across the whole of Australia.

It was great to see the behind scenes of all the hard work that goes into preparing the bulls that come over to Fitzroy Crossing Bull Sale every year. A bull sale is not just a one-day event. The process starts way back to when the calf is born. Continuous data is reported from day 1, to first identifying its mother, to weight, its class, growth and progress. Bull studs not only just produce high quality bulls, a lot are self-sufficient with growing their own pastures for silage through pivots.

Bull Studs are such a diverse enterprise; with each stud focusing in different areas, allowing there to be certain bulls for certain clients based on such a broad production desire. Each sale has designated bulls to be sold, depending on the production/environment they are trying to reach.

I will forever be grateful for this experience; this has been a once in a life time opportunity. I learnt so much over the 10 days that will help me in my future career. I would especially like to thank all the vendors, and the Fitzroy Bull Sale Committee for the chance to travel to Oueensland to see each personal process.

### JAMES MAHONEY

"Jubilee Downs" - Fitzroy Crossing

### DAY 1

The first day of our trip started in Rockhampton where myself and James landed at 7am, where we were met by Johnny Edwards from Barlyne Pastoral.

Our first stop was the Brahman Week Bull Sale, after only seeing the Fitzrov Bull Sale it came as a shock to see how large the facilities were. Johnny walked us around the sale pens examining bulls and introducing us to various stud owners and vendors, while taking us into the detail about the criteria of traits and characteristics he looks for when selecting bulls for his herd. There were 752 Bulls in the sale and while we only stayed around for a few hours of the sale it was an amazing experience. That afternoon we travelled just outside of Rockhampton to the Karinya Sale Yard where we looked at their selection of Grey Brahman Bulls that would go under the hammer the following week at their own sale.

### DAY 2

We had the opportunity to go out to Mt Elsa, Steve Farmer - SC Droughtmasters Stud, where we were given a tour of his property. Steve talked us through operations at Mt Elsa, from centre pivots, commercial Droughtmasters, Stud Droughtmasters, Wagyu and a mixed mob of Brahmans. We were also given the opportunity to see Steve's Stud Droughtmaster sale team for the Nebo Bull sale.

### DAY 3

After watching the closing of the 2024 Brahman Week Sale, Steve Farmer had organised a trip out to the Rocky Repro where we met the operations manager, George North. He gave us a tour of the centre and the bulls living at the centre while they collected semen. He also showed us how they collect and analyse the semen samples, along with the storage shed and how the samples are stored. We then travelled to Clermont for the preparations of the first Queenslander and Tropical Red Bull Sale. This is also where we caught up with Jimmy Edwards from Barlyne Pastoral and Darren Castle of Bar Boot Brahmans.

### DAY 4

Once in Clermont we had to set up for the upcoming sale the following day, during this time we met different vendors and painted and washed bulls for the sale.

### DAY 5

The Clermont Queenslander and Tropical Red Bull Sale was run by Jake Kennedy at Kennedy Livestock & Property, this sale had an offering of Grey/Red Brahmans, Droughtmasters and Queenslanders, during the sale me and Jimmy were part of the crew supplying the bulls to the sale ring. This was the first Queenslander and Tropical Red Bull sale, and it didn't go as well as everyone had hoped, with a lot of the lots being passed in. This was an eyeopening experience into the struggles of first-time sales and the struggles some vendors face when selling their cattle to a new market.

### DAY 6

We drove from Clermont to Barlyne Pastoral and on the way stopped in a Smart Berries Mundubbera Blueberry Farm where we given a farm tour by Johnny's sister Sally and her husband Kirk who run and manage the farm. We then continued our trip to Barlyne.

### **DAY 7**

Johnny took us to a block that houses his weaner heifers and steers, while we were there we rotated the heifers and had a bit of a walk through on what criteria Johnny goes through to select which heifers he keeps for the breeding herds, we also brought in the steers to be separated into different weight groups as Johnny was looking to fatten them up for sale. Once back at Barlyne we had a tour of the property, Johnny showed us some of the different paddocks and water points as well as a few of his breeding herd and stud cows.

### DAY 8

After an early start we were heading for the Gibbs Family (Muan Brahmans) BigMeats Abattoir in Biggenden, where we were lucky enough to be given a tour of their facilities. We then headed down to the feedlot where we were shown how they introduce cattle into the feedlot and what processes

are in place in regards to data collection and processing. Also being able to look at the 2024 batch of future bulls in the feedlot. A short drive down the road was the main operation of Muan Brahmans where we were met by Lenny Gibbs the owner, he gave us a tour of the onsite bull feedlot where he agists other people's bulls for future sales and also their stud Brahman cows, weaner heifers and stud bulls. I found this part of the trip very interesting as the Gibbs family have got a whole operation set up, from farm to feedlot and then to meat works, while also supplying quality bulls for sale.

Once finished at Muan we travelled back to Gayndah to another block of Barlyne's called Kajabbi where Johnny keeps a herd of Queenslander cows, while there we checked fences and moved a mob of stranger cows back to where they belonged, following this we had a tour of Riverton Orchard across the river from Kajabbi.

### DAY 9

Leaving Barlyne early we travelled to Bar Boot Brahmans near Kingaroy where we met Darren, Jacqui and Tony Castle. Tony then took us to put in a new boundary fence on a block that he had just started leasing. Once finished the fencing we returned to Bar Boot and waited for Michael Flynn from Valera Vale Droughtmasters to pick us up and take us to his small property in Milbong.

### **DAY 10**

On our way out to Michael's bull preparation property Avilion at Greymare we stopped into the Silvervale sale yards where Micheal was wanting to buy a handful of small weaners to fatten up and then sell later on. Once at Avilion we met John who is the farm manger at Avilion, he had already brought a selection of Droughtmaster bulls up to be drafted into culls and divided between Valera Vale, Avilion and Micheal's home block, we also had the opportunity to semen test two

bulls. Michael is a vet and has done a lot of work in genetics in relation to cattle. He explained to us how to record certain types of data and how that data is interpreted to predict certain qualities that bulls can put into it's offspring, using this data he is able to keep adding different traits and qualities that he wants into his herd.

### **DAY 11**

Our last day of the trip we travelled into Brisbane to the JBS Dinmore Meat works. We were lucky enough to be given a private tour by the plant's general manager Murray Wilson. He gave us an introduction to the plant where they have 2000 staff employed at the plant at one time and over a 24 hour shift they were able to process 3500 head. He was able to show us the full extent of the plant. We started at the end of the process and worked our way back. Seeing the storage and trucking areas, then into the packing and boxing area. It was interesting to see how automated the whole packaging and sorting system was as a conveyor fed the boxed meat into different locations based on the colour and grade of the meat. Our next stop was the butchering floor where hundreds of people work together to break down the carcasses into different cuts. We then followed the line into the fridges where hundreds of carcasses are kept waiting to be transported to the butchering floor. The last part of the tour was the killing floor where hundreds of people and machines worked to break down a whole carcass into one that was ready to be cut up. Murray Explained to us that nothing goes to waste every product of the beast is used in some way. It was amazing to see the scale of the whole operation and hard to get your head around how quick and efficient their whole process really is.

Over the 11 days I learnt a lot of new things and also added onto current knowledge, I learnt about new techniques to pick out specific qualities in bulls, how to select

different bulls for different types of country and different types of herds. I dove into the side of cattle genetics, which I have never done much in before so it was really interesting to learn and understand that side of the industry. We were able to experience a large scale bull sale and also a sale just starting up. It was an unforgettable experience and I would encourage anyone who

is given the opportunity to apply for the scholarship. I would like to give a special thanks the Fitzroy Crossing Bull Sale Committee for funding the scholarship and also a special thanks to Johnny and Rachael from Barlyne for organising everything on the QLD side. I would also like to thank Jimmy Edwards, Robin Finger, Darren and Jacqui Castle, Michael and Tracy Flynn, Steve Farmer. Lenny and Sandra Gibbs and everyone who gave up their time to show myself and James around and teach us and help us understand a more technical and advanced side of the industry.

## LIVESTOCK AUCTION TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SALE

### CHAPTER ONE - PRELIMINARY

- (a) A vendor is bound by these terms and conditions by offering livestock for sale by auction.
  - (b) An agent (which includes an auctioneer) is bound by these terms and conditions by conducting an auction sale
- conditions by conducting an auction sale.

  A buyer is bound by these terms and conditions by bidding at auction.

  In these terms the expression auctioneer, agent, buyer and vendor respectively includes the servants, contractors, agents of each of them. The auctioneer, agent, buyer and vendor shall be wholly responsible for the acts and omissions of their respective servants, contractors and agents. The term "auctioneer" includes, so far as the law and context permits, the vendor's agent,
  - (b) When used in these terms the expressions "companion animals" means all animals originating from a property on a particular day. Where lots are split and sent to multiple establishments, then all of these animals shall be regarded as companions.
- The following applies in interpreting these terms and conditions:
  - (a) The following words have the following meanings
    - The following words have the following meanings: Fees means all levies, charges, fees, costs and other expenses incurred or relating to these terms and conditions and the sale and purchase of livestock including, without limitation, transaction levies, yard and weigh dues, cartage, advertising and rebates, and whether paid for, or incurred, by the agent; Livestock means animals auctioned pursuant to these terms and conditions; and
    - Price means the amount at which the lot has been sold to the buyer referred to in clause 7 of these terms and conditions

      (i) plus any Fees and other expenses incurred in relation to the purchase of livestock that are payable by the buyer; and
  - (ii) plus any GST added in accordance with clause 12.

    These terms and conditions are subject to legislation or regulation in the State in which the auction is conducted and in the event of any conflict then the legislation or regulation will prevail. The provisions of these terms and conditions are in addition to, and do not derogate from, the duties and rights of vendors, agents and buyers set out in legislation and regulation in the State in which the auction is conducted.

### CHAPTER TWO - STANDARD TERMS OF SALE

- Subject to any reserve price, and to the right, prior to the fall of the hammer, of the vendor to withdraw any lot without declaring the reserve, the highest bidder shall be the burger.
- The auctioneer has the right to bid on behalf of the vendor provided that right is notified prior to the commencement of the sale and is subject to State law. A bid cannot be made or accepted after the fall of the hammer unless, in
- accordance with clause 8, the auctioneer decides to put the lot up again.
- The last price called by the auctioneer at the fall of the hammer shall be the amount at which the lot has been sold. In the event of a disputed bid, the auctioneer is the sole arbitrator of the successful bidder or the auctioneer's
- The auctioneer may refuse to accept any bid which, in the auctioneer's opinion, is not in the best interests of the vendor and need not give reasons for doing so. A bidder shall be deemed to be a principal unless, prior to bidding, the bidder has given to the auctioneer a copy of written authority to bid for or on behalf of another
- The successful bidder at a livestock auction sale must give to the auctioneer at the fall of the hammer:

  - (a) the purchaser's name; or (b) the bid card number which identifies the purchaser; or
  - (c) the name of the person on whose behalf the successful bid was made; and
- (d) the Property Identification Code (known as the "PIC") of destination.

  The auction shall be conducted on the basis that the bid price shall be exclusive of Goods and Services Tax (GST), GST shall be added after the fall of the hammer for those sales subject to GST.
- The vendor warrants that the
  - (a) vendor has (or will have) the right to sell the livestock at the time of delivery; and (b) buyer will obtain title on completion of the buyer's obligation under these terms
- and conditions.

  If a buyer does not comply with any of these terms and conditions, which includes the requirements of State law, any livestock knocked down to that buyer may be re-sold by public auction or private contract in whatever lots and manner the auctioneer decides. The re-sale may be with or without notice and shall be at the buyer's risk. The buyer is responsible for all loss and expense arising out of a re-sale and is not entitled to any resulting profit.

  The buyer of livestock must pay the agent the full amount of the purchase price in immediate fluids on varieting of a tax injuries. Payment is required not not delivery.
- immediate funds on receipt of a tax invoice. Payment is required prior to delivery unless some other time for payment is specified in a written agreement between the buyer and the auctioneer that was made before the fall of the hammer. If, before delivery, payment has not been made then clauses 20 to 23 apply.

No person may bid unless, prior to the commencement of the sale, that person has made arrangements satisfactory to the auctioneer for payment for livestock purchased.   - (i) delivery is taken by a representative of the buyer; (ii) departure of the animal from the purchaser's delivery pen; or

  - (ii) departure of the animal from the purchaser's delivery pen; or
    (iii) one hour after the last animal is:

    a. in the case of pre-sale weighing, sold; or
    b. in the case of post-sale weighing, sold; or
    b. in the case of post-sale weighing, weighed.

    (c) During the time for rejection the buyer may reject any animal which is lame,
    blind or diseased where that condition existed prior to the fall of the hammer
    but could not be reasonably observed when the animal was in the selling pen.

    (d) If the purchaser rejects an animal during the time for rejection then the sale of
    that animal is cancelled and the animal is returned to the vendor or sold on such
    terms as any buyer and the agent may agree, after the agent has disclosed the
    reason for rejection to that buyer.

    (e) This sub-fause anniles only to cattle which are sold in Queensland at auction

  If delivery is made to, or possession obtained by, the buyer or its representative before full payment of the Price, then until full payment is received, the buyer:

  (b) holds the livestock as ballee only for the vendor;
  (c) must act in a fiduciary capacity in its relationship with the vendor;

  (f) may make a bona fide sale for market value of any or all of the livestock. As between the buyer and the subsequent buyer, the sale shall be made by the buyer in its own name and not as agent for the vendor, however as between the vendor and buyer, the sale shall be made as bailee and agent for the vendor; and g) must keep and account for the proceeds of any subsequent sale separately from its other money and hold those proceeds, together with the benefits of any rights against subsequent buyers, on trust for the vendor.

    or possession obtained by, the buyer or its representative, interest may be
    charged at the rate usually charged by the agent for overdue accounts on any
    amounts which remain owing at any time.

    The buyer may not make any claim against the vendor for actions by the vendor
    or its agent under clauses 20 or 21 and indemnifies the vendor and its agent
    against any loss, damage, costs, expenses, penalties, fines or claims suffered by
- the vendor, the agent or any person or entity arising from the vendor exercising its rights under clauses 20 or 21.
- Clause 23 applies whenever the agent pays the vendor before being paid by the buyer, which the agent is not bound to do. The agent is then the del credere agend the vendor at law.

- Regardless of whether or not a sale has occurred the agent may, but is not under obligation so to do, instead of deducting payments owed to it by the vendor, debit the amount of the commission and fees to an account held in the name of the vendor by the agent.

  The auctioneer has been retained by the vendor as auctioneer for the purpose of selling the livestock comprised in the lots. The terms of engagement between the auctioneer and the vendor do not extend to the provision of advice by the auctioneer to the vendor in relation to the safety or otherwise of the sale ring, the saleyards and the surrounding environments.

The vendor, the agent and the buyer agree to comply with their several duties under the Australian Welfare Standards and Guidelines for the Land Transport of Livestock in accordance with any other or additional requirements of animal welfare legislation specific to the State or States in which livestock are consigned, managed, received, transported and treated in the course of the auction process.

### CHAPTER THREE VENDOR WARRANTY FOR CORRECT PRESENTATION AND DECLARATION

This chapter applies only in the case of livestock and their companion animals sold at auction for slaughter when the buyer is the slaughterer and the livestock are transported direct from the sale yard to the meatworks at which they are

- slaughtered. This chapter does not apply if the buyer is a trader who subsequently resells the livestock to a slaughterer. A slaughterer is any person who pays the AMPC Processor levy.
- The warranty of a vendor is that livestock and their companion animals offered for
  - (a) pass DAFF and other regulatory authority requirements and inspections at the time of slaughter; (DAFF refers to Federal Government Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry);

    (b) are of merchantable quality;

    (c) carry an NLIS device in accordance with State law;

  - (g) in the case where a representation has been made in the pre-sale catalogue that the livestock have particular characteristics or are fit for a particular purpose or market, and such representations are based on information in the National Vendor Declaration, the livestock will have those characteristics or when the particular purpose or market; and

    (g) all information in any National Vendor Declaration provided by the vendor is true, complete and correct in all material respects.
- In the event of a breach by the vendor of the vendor's warranty and provided such breach is notified by the buyer to the agent by 5:00pm on the 7th day after the fall of the hammer then the buyer is not liable to pay the portion of the Price of such of the vendor's livestock to which the breach applies. However if the breach by the vendor is such that the livestock are not rejected outright but are instead downgraded then the buyer will pay the value of the livestock at their next highest and best use.
- - Investock at their next highest and best use. In the case of a breach by the vendor of the vendor's warranty then the vendor will also be liable to the buyer for any further losses which the buyer might establish but the buyer will take all reasonable steps in co-operation with the agent and vendor to mitigate both the effect of the breach and the amount of any loss. Where a sentinel animal of a lot tests positive for chemical residue, or foreign material contamination and provided such test is certified and notified as required by these vendor warranty terms, then:
- - (a) the buyer will be entitled to delay payment for the price of all livestock in that
  - (b) the vendor has the option, at the vendor's cost, of collecting the companion animals and returning them to the vendor's property; or of having the livestock slaughtered in which event the risk of further condemnations will be that of the vendor. Where product integrity is potentially jeopardised, the Processor has the right to refuse slaughter and send the livestock back to the consigning property at the vendor's cost.
- The auctioneer is liable to the buyer in respect of any breach of the vendor's
  - The auctioneer is liable to the buyer in respect of any oreach of the vendors warranty arising out of:

    (a) any error, by the auctioneer, of transcription of information from the National Vendor Declaration completed by the vendor to the pre-sale catalogue or the buyers post-sale summan;

    (b) any failure by the auctioneer to notify the buyer, prior to bidding, of any breach

  - any launce by the auctioneer to nounty me buyer, prior to blodding, or any brea by the vendor of the warranty of the vendor if the buyer establishes that the agent knew of such breach prior to the sale; and any failure by the auctioneer to disclose prior to bidding, and in the presale catalogue, that the vendor has failed to provide a National Vendor Declaratio that is complete in all material aspects.

### CHAPTER FOUR - OWNERS RISK FOR CONDITION OF CATTLE

- This chapter applies only in the case of cattle and their companion animals sold at auction for slaughter when the buyer is the slaughterer and the cattle are transported direct from the sale yard to the meatworks at which they are slaughtered. This chapter does not apply if the buyer is a trader who subseque resells cattle to a slaughterer. A slaughterer is any person who pays the AMPC
- resels cattle to a siaughterer. A slaughterer is any person who pays the AWPL. Processor levy. Owners risk reflects the producer's responsibility to provide slaughter cattle for sale that are fit for human consumption. Cattle are fit for human consumption if they are not condemned as unfit by the relevant government department. Owners risk applies if the condemnation is due to a condition in the animal which the buyer establishes, by the certificate issued by the relevant government department, existed prior to the fall of the hammer.
- A buyer with the benefit of owners risk protection is not liable to pay the Price of that animal to the vendor. The buyer remains nevertheless liable for all costs incurred after the fall of the hammer in transport, slaughter, testing and disposal of the name.
- Owners risk protection is available to the buyer of cattle to which this chapt applies if all of the following are satisfied:
  - applies had not the blooming are satisfied.

    (a) a certificate is issued by the relevant government department which states the relevant NLIS RFID tag number and PIC, the date of the certificate, the reason for condemnation and that the reason for condemnation existed prior to the fall of the hammer:
  - on the naminer;

    (b) the certificate is received by the selling agent either in its original form or by fax by 5:00pm on the 7th day after the fall of the hammer; and

    (c) if the condemnation is due to chemical residue the certificate follows testing
  - in a laboratory approved by the relevant government department which establishes maximum residue limits in excess of the Australian limit.
- Owners risk does not apply, and the buyer must pay for the cattle, if the reason for condemnation is any of the following:

  - (a) bruising, (b) fever,
  - partial condemnation, or
     d) emaciation.

### CHAPTER FIVE - NOTICES REQUIRED BY STATE LEGISLATION

NSW Legislation Property, Stock and Business Agents Act 2002 Warnings Penalties for collusive practices. It is an offence against the Property, Stock and Business Agents Act 2002 for a person to do any of the following as a result of a collusive practice regents Act 2002 to a person to do any or the loudeng as a less to to induce or attempt to induce another person by a collusive practice to do any of the following:

(b) to abstain from bidding; or
(ii) to bid to a limited extent only; or

- (iii) to do any other act that might prevent free and open competition.

Severe penalties may be imposed on persons convicted of collusive practices.

The auctioneer has the right to make one bid on behalf of the vendor if the auctioneer clearly and precisely announces that fact prior to the sale.

### Tasmanian Legislation

The auctioneer must not appear to acknowledge a dummy bid. A buyer must not give, agree to give or offer a gift or other consideration to a person for abstaining from bidding and a person must not accept any gift or consideration for abstaining

from bidding.

A person must not participate in collusive practices by way of making or receiving an unlawful promise to abstain from bidding, not to bid except to a limited extent or do any other thing which may prevent free and open competition.
